REGULATIONS FOR THE WAIKATO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND

This scholarship has been established for the benefit of members or employees of members of the Waikato Chamber of Commerce to assist a participant to undertake a programme of study offered through Corporate & Executive Education at the Waikato Management School.

REGULATIONS

1. The Waikato Chamber of Commerce Business Scholarship is awarded annually to assist a participant to undertake study at Postgraduate level in Hamilton namely the Postgraduate Diploma in Management Studies (evening programme) or Part I of the Waikato Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme through Corporate & Executive Education at the Waikato Management School, University of Waikato.
2. The value of the Scholarship is equivalent to half of the total programme fees and will be credited to the recipient's fees account at the University of Waikato. The scholarship will be offered in two instalments, the first at the commencement of the programme and the second half way through the programme.
3. The successful candidate will be expected to complete the proposed programme. The Selection Panel may terminate a Scholarship and recoup any funds awarded if the recipient does not meet this requirement.
4. The Scholarship will be offered on the basis of demonstrated:
 - past academic performance;
 - contribution to business and the community;
 - management experience;
 - leadership potential.
5. To be eligible to apply for the Scholarship applicants must:
 - be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand;
 - be a member or employee of a member of the Waikato Chamber of Commerce
 - have a minimum of five years relevant work experience;
 - have a tertiary or relevant professional qualification (in some cases the requirement for formal degree qualifications may be waived where relevant practical experience is deemed to offset the need for prior tertiary study;
 - have the support of his/her employer;
 - Not already be enrolled in a Postgraduate Diploma in Management Studies or Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme with the Waikato Management School, University of Waikato;
 - Not have been a previous recipient of any Waikato Management School, University of Waikato scholarship.

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6. The Waikato Chamber of Commerce Business Scholarship will be awarded on the recommendation of a Selection Panel which shall include the Chief Executive Officer (or nominee) from the Waikato Chamber of Commerce and the Director of The Centre for Corporate & Executive Education (or nominee).
7. The Selection Panel may refrain from making a recommendation if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
8. Along with the completed application form, applicants should submit a statement outlining their reason for wishing to undertake this study, their curriculum vitae and at least two references to support the application (including one from their employer if currently employed).
9. Applications should be EITHER :

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10. Applicants will be advised in writing following the closing date whether they have been short-listed for an interview with the Selection Panel.
11. The offer of a Scholarship must be accepted by the date indicated in the letter of offer. If any candidate declines a Scholarship or does not take it up, the Selection Panel may offer the Scholarship to another person.
12. A Scholarship shall be taken up in the year for which it is offered.
13. In accepting the Scholarship, the recipient undertakes to present a short summary of the outcome of their study to a nominated audience at a time after the conclusion of the papers covered by the Scholarship.
14. The University of Waikato may, with the consent of the Waikato Chamber of Commerce vary these regulations from time to time.
15. The closing date for applications is **30 November** in the year preceding the study to be undertaken (although a later date may apply in the year the first scholarship is awarded).

I understand that:

1. If I am offered and accept a Waikato Chamber of Commerce Business Scholarship, I will only be eligible to be formally awarded the Scholarship if enrolled at The University of Waikato in the year of tenure and comply with any other specific requirements of the scholarship.

The Scholarships Committee may terminate a Scholarship at any time and recoup any funds awarded, if it is satisfied that the holder is not following the required programme or is not otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Scholarship. The holder of a Scholarship shall have the right to appeal to the Academic Board against any decision to terminate the award.
